Our “pop-up shop with soul”, St Pat’s Rack sells an eclectic and quirky mix of vintage and local creations. All proceeds from sales will go back to help the homeless within the local community – enabling St Patrick’s Community Support Centre to continue its 40 year strong service. St Pat’s Rack is run by volunteers and cannot exist without the generous support from the community. It is located at 72 Adelaide Street, Fremantle and is open Tuesday to Saturday from 10am to 3pm.
