



# Get to the CORE for our apple experience tours!



**It's a Perth Hills must-do experience. You'll learn about Perth's first cidery, its finest ciders, the brewing process and a few historical yarns from this 4th generation property.**

**APPLE EXPERIENCE TOUR CONDITIONS:** Tours must be pre-booked with a 50% non-refundable deposit and full payment one week in advance. Any outstanding amount from extra participants are to be finalised before the tour commences. Tours take place rain, hail and shine. Please wear enclosed shoes, bring a hat and be ready for any weather conditions.

Guests not wishing to complete the orchard walk may relax on the deck and soak up the view.

Bus parking is available in the main carpark — take the first entrance. Shire restrictions stipulate that buses are NOT to park on the road.

**SPRING** Flowering plums, apples, pears. Apple and pear buds (mid spring).

**SUMMER** Leafy and green trees. Fruit in abundance including plums, apples and pears. Harvesting starts December to January (with plums), February to April (apples and pears).

**AUTUMN** Stunning autumn colours. Pears and apples are harvested.

**WINTER** Some autumn colours (early winter). Citrus fruit available but no leaves or fruit on apple and pear trees.
